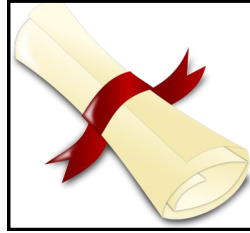

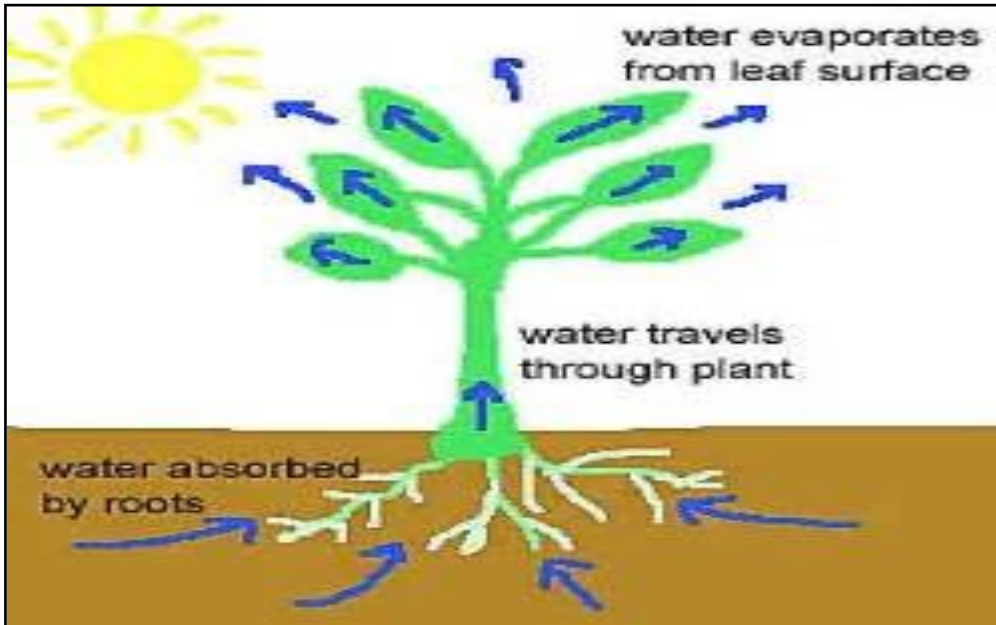

Room 12 have been conducting an experiment by putting a white rose in a glass vial with water and food dye, the result was that the flower had changed into the colour of the food dye. 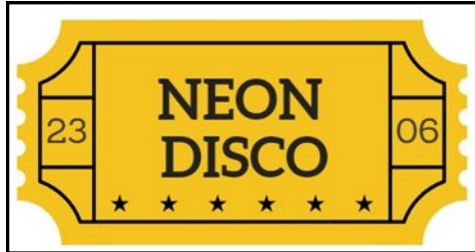
