

## APPROVED STANDARD OF DRESS AND SCHOOL UNIFORM

At all times students must be clean and well groomed, appropriately and neatly dressed. Singlet tops, transparent materials, bare midriffs, commercial logos/designs, torn or frayed clothing, beach wear, advertising or slogans are considered to be inappropriate.

The wearing of jewellery is not permitted for safety reasons. Sleepers and studs in ears are permitted. Watches are permitted.

Long hair must be tied back for safety and health reasons.

Scarves are not to be worn for safety reasons.

Cosmetics, including nail polish, are not acceptable for school.

Students must wear suitable footwear. Shoes and socks, sandals with ankle straps and joggers are acceptable.

### SPORT

- Faction t-shirt in appropriate colour may be worn on Fridays and for Physical Education and intra school sports carnivals.
- Appropriate footwear is to be worn at all times.

### EXCURSIONS

Appropriate uniform will be detailed in excursion information and letters of approval.

## APPROVED UNIFORM

Official school colours are gold and black.



The approved uniform consists of:

### GIRLS

- Black jacket with logo
- Gold and black collar type polo shirt
- Black skirt, shorts, or skort
- Black track pants, cargo pants or trousers
- Gold and black check college style dress
- No football shorts, brief shorts or board shorts
- Plain black leggings are permitted under a dress or skirt

### BOYS

- Black jacket with logo
- Gold and black collar type polo shirt
- Black shorts
- Black track pants, cargo pants or trousers
- No football shorts, brief shorts or board shorts

### HATS

The school operates a "NO HAT, NO PLAY" policy in the sun and students must wear approved school hats during outdoor activities all year round. The school hat is a black bucket hat with logo and faction colour on the inside.

## Dress Code and Uniform Policy

The Mount Pleasant Primary School Board has established a dress code for all students from Kindergarten to Year 6 attending the school.

The Mount Pleasant Primary School community believes that a school uniform will benefit the students by:

- Developing a sense of pride
- Fostering a sense of community
- Enhancing the public image of the school
- Encouraging equity among students
- Ensuring students are dressed safely and appropriately for school activities
- Protecting students from harmful exposure to the sun.



## POLICY

It is school policy that:

- Approved uniform items should be worn at school.
- Students should wear the approved uniform when representing sporting or cultural events and other excursions.

- Acceptance of enrolment at Mount Pleasant Primary School assumes acceptance of the dress code.
- Students who, for religious or health reasons, wish to seek a variation to the School Dress Code are to discuss any exceptions with the Principal. Staff will be informed of any students granted a modification to the Dress Code.



## ADVICE TO STUDENTS ON THE DRESS CODE

- Items in the designated school colours (including hats) may be purchased from Willetton Uniforms, the designated uniform supplier.
- Students whose families may experience financial difficulties regarding the purchase of a uniform should contact the School Administration to discuss the situation.

## REVIEW OF DRESS CODE

The dress code is reviewed and any variation is approved by the School Board on a regular basis to establish the standard of dress required when attending Mount Pleasant Primary School.

The School Board is required to consult the staff and the parent body via the P&C on refinements to the uniform before making any changes to the dress code.

A copy of the dress code is included in the parent information handbook, notice boards, the school website and is also available at the school office.

## SANCTIONS

A letter will be sent home to parents of students who disregard the Dress Code. Students may also be withdrawn from representing the school if they are not wearing the appropriate uniform.
